Notice is hereby given, in accordance with the provisions of the Roads Act 1993 of the intention of Limerick City and County Council to close the sections of roads detailed hereunder at the specified locations and times to facilitate the Regeneron Great Limerick Run 2026 on Sunday 3rd May 2026.

Temporary Road Closures & Parking Restrictions

• Park & Ride Facility will be provided on the Dock Road (R510) at the Limerick Greyhound Stadium (Details to be Confirmed) by the Event Organiser.
• Disc Parking Areas outside of the main Race Route can be availed of.
• Please avail of Multistorey Parking where these venues are open and not affected by the Race Route or the other events taking place in the City Centre over the May Bank Holiday weekend.
